#### 4.1. Description of Necessary Measures

#### 4.2. Most Important Symptoms and Effects, Acute and Delayed

Causes severe skin burns and eye damage **WARNING!** Corrosive liquid. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Use with adequate ventilation. May be harmful if swallowed. If ingested, do not induce vomiting. Dilute with water and call a physician. Wash areas of contact with plenty of water for 15 minutes. For eyes, get medical attention. **EYE CONTACT:** May cause irritation, redness, pain, and tearing. **SKIN CONTACT:** May cause serious damage to the skin. Effects may include redness, pain, skin burns.

#### 4.3. Immediate Medical Attention or Special Treatment Needed

Immediately call a poison center or doctor. Irrigate immediately with large quantity of water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician if irritation develops. Remove to fresh air. 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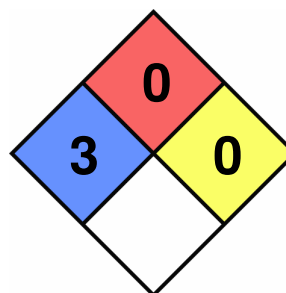
