4.1. Description of Necessary Measures

Eye Contact: IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. May cause irritation, redness, pain, and tearing.

4.2. Most Important Symptoms and Effects, Acute and Delayed

4.3. Immediate Medical Attention or Special Treatment Needed

Irrigate immediately with large quantity of water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention immediately. Remove to fresh air. Give artificial respiration if necessary. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen. Wipe off any excess material from skin and then immediately flush with plenty of soap and water for at least 15 minutes. Apply bandages soaked in Magnesium Sulfate. Administer with milk, chewable calcium carbonate tablets or milk of magnesia. Vomiting may occur spontaneously. Do not induce. Call a physician immediately.

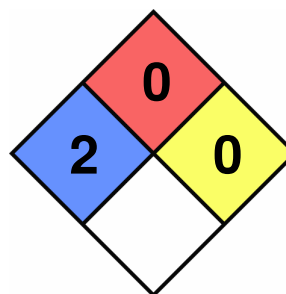
